



How can I identify the model and year of my GEM car?




GEM 1999 - 2004

- Charger plug is located under the seat
- Small Round Display behind Steering wheel
- 4 wheel drum brakes
- The eight digit in the Vehicle Identification number would be “9,0,1,2,3,4” indicating the year.
- Model Year Sticker located on bottom side of roof on driver side



GEM 2005 - Current

- Large Square Shaped Digital Display behind Steering Wheel
- Charger Is plug is located in front hood
- VIN number is located on driver side dash beneath the steering column.
- Model Year Sticker located on bottom side of roof on driver side
